Dear friend of our Earth!

This we cannot and do not want to impose on our Congress participants.

So we immediately started looking for another location to be able to hold our Congress this year—which, by the way, will be an Anniversary Congress, namely the 25th! We found what we were looking for in Switzerland, in Regensdorf near Zurich. Despite high occupancy, the Hotel Mövenpick there still had free rooms available. However, the Congress will take place a little earlier than usual, from Thursday, October 20th, 2022 (7 p.m.) to Sunday, October 23rd, 2022 (1 p.m.). And so, we from The World Foundation for Natural Science are very much looking forward to welcoming you very soon in Switzerland, when we will gather from all over the world to spend this extended weekend in friendship and share all the valuable experiences and precious knowledge with each other.

Since our last Congress, much has indeed happened and the world has changed at a rapid speed. The world literally cries out for solutions, and there is much to be done to restore balance to our unique planet Earth and heal it together with its many inhabitants, whether they have two or more legs, are at home in the air or in the water, or have been rooted in the same place for millennia. We find ourselves on the long road to building a true science of life, as exemplified daily by nature, which connects us to The Source of all Life.
